CALDER, a rebellious member of Leif's crew, leader of the MUTINEERS

### The LOYAL SAILORS:

HALFDAN, sensible, warm and slightly older than the other sailors STEN and BRANDT, brothers, practical types with good sense of humour SIGURD, honest but can be pessimistic GISLI, father of two

### The MUTINEERS:

OSKAR, angry but sharper than the other mutineers KETIL, brash and unintelligent ULF, sceptical of everything

A slash between lines by different characters indicates they are sung at the same time (where columns are impractical)

## ACT I

# SCENE 1, LEIF ERIKSON - AT SEA then BJARNI'S HOVEL

# Song 1.1 Leif Erikson (LEIF, BJARNI, TYRKER, CALDER, SAILORS, 8m)

LEIF and his crew of SAILORS are navigating through a rough sea. TYRKER navigates and HALFDAN is at the helm. They sing a boisterous shanty:

SAILORS
Hear the winds roar!
Hear the winds roar!
No sign that it's going to ease.
But still we'll explore
To find a new shore.
Together we'll master the seas.

TYRKER

Time to steer East, Leif!

LEIF

Right you are, Tyrker. Stand by to tack! Man the sheets! Ready about!

SAILORS Ready!

LEIF

Hard a-port! Loose the jiblines! Mind the heel! Haul taut, haul taut!

TYRKER

Handsomely now.

LEIF

Let her come to, Halfdan!

HALFDAN

Aye!

TYRKER

That's a fine course.

LEIF

Midships now. 1 At ease, all.

#### TYRKER

Bjarni's dwelling should lie right ahead. I hope he's got something for us.

#### LEIF

Of course he will! If you'd sighted a new land I think you'd have something to say about it.

#### CALDER

Who is this Bjarni anyway?

#### LEIF

A legendary explorer.

#### OSKAR

As legendary as the last, I'll bet!

#### TYRKER

He's our best lead so far.

#### CALDER

You're really scraping the barrel now, ain't you. We've followed rumours of land half way across the oceans and got nothing to show for it.

### ULF

It makes you think Erik might be right. Maybe there isn't any land left to find.

#### KETIL

Aye, if the King says so.

#### BRANDI

Erik couldn't see land out to the West if it was half a league away.

Tack Turn across the wind

Sheets Ropes

Ready about Warning that they are about to tack

Hard a-port Turn the tiller fully to port (left) so the boat turns

sharply to starboard (right)

Loose the jiblines Let off the ropes holding the jib (one of the sails) Haul taut  $\qquad$  Pull the jiblines tight (on the opposite side of the ship)

Come to Bring the ship to a stable course close to the wind

Midships Stop turning the ship

STEN

Aye, when did we ever listen to him?

HALFDAN

Tell us more, Leif.

LEIF

Rumour has it he got blown off course while on a trading mission -

KETIL

Blown off course? That bodes well!

LEIF

- and sighted land out to the West.

CALDER

What use is it if he's found it already? Thought you wanted new land, not old land!

LEIF

That's the thing: he never landed.

The SAILORS protest.

CALDER

Why wouldn't he land?

TYRKER

We're not sure. But it's been twenty years and no-one's managed to find it since.

CALDER

Twenty years!

ULF

You'd think we'd have heard about it before, wouldn't you?

TYRKER

Let's at least hear what he has to say. (Pointing) That's where we're headed!

LEIF

All hands, stand by to lay anchor!

SAILORS

Hear the winds roar!
Hear the winds roar!
No sign that it's going to ease.
But still we'll explore
To find a new shore.
Together we'll master the seas.

The SAILORS arrive at BJARNI's hovel, a squalid dwelling scattered with yellowing maps and rusty navigation instruments, where he is sat in a low chair by a small table. LEIF strides in, followed by the other SAILORS.

LEIF

Bjarni Herjolfsson!

I'm here to finish what you started.
I'm here to hear what you know
Of a voyage that long since departed,
Of a story you told long ago.

I've heard that you sighted a land. Ever since, no one's managed to reach it. I'm here to finish what you started. Bjarni, I intend to complete it.

BJARNI gets up and moves slowly towards LEIF, who holds his ground.

BJARNI

A visitor! Since last one came A score of years has gone. But I'm not fooled, I know your aim, I smell just what you want.

LEIF


Whatever do you mean?
